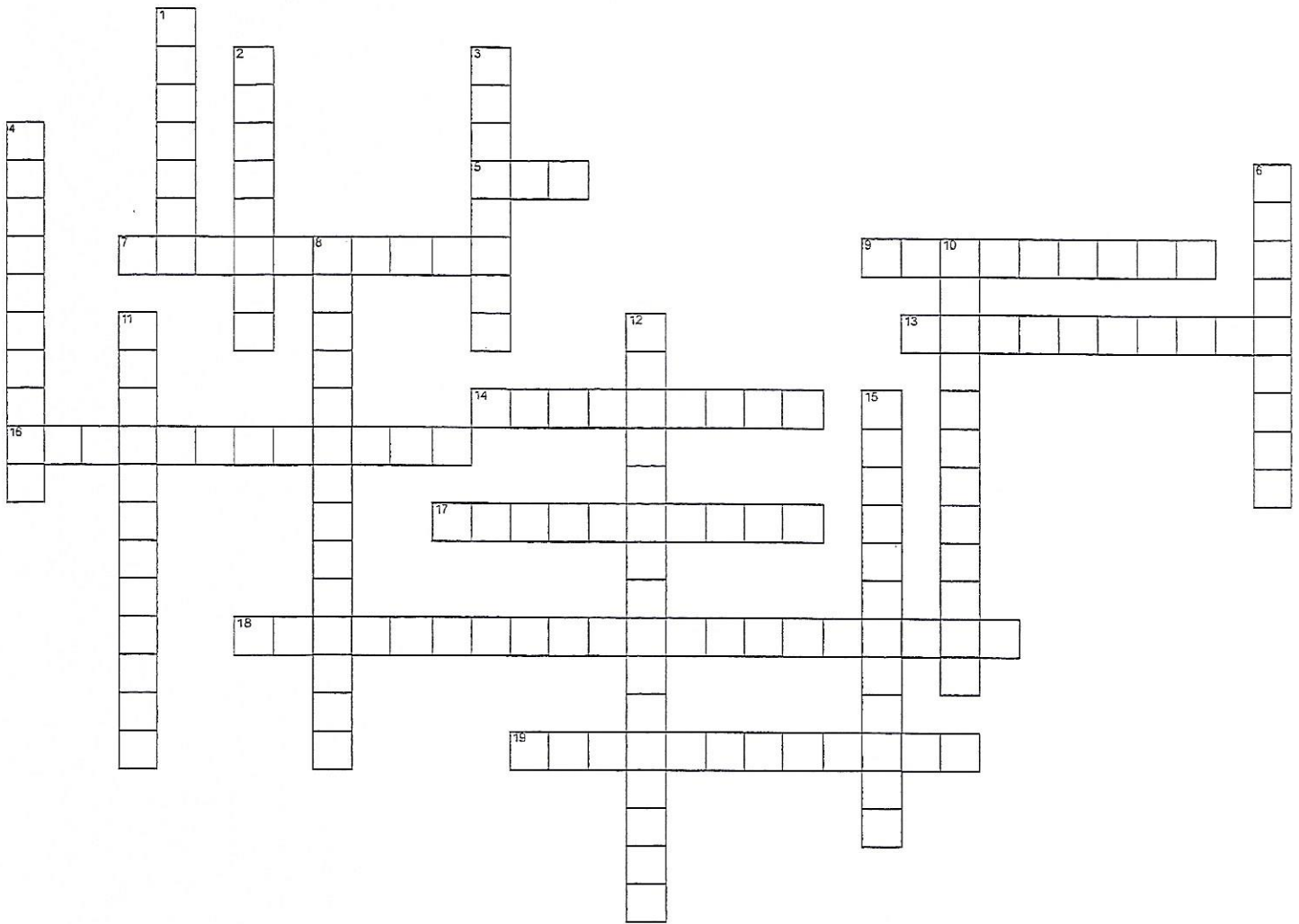


Alcohol Study Guide
